## WHAT WILL WE DO IN SAN ANTONIO?

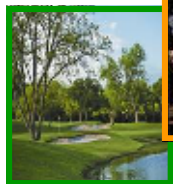
You already know about the golf excursion planned for Sat, Nov 1; but what will the rest of us do during the reunion?
